Legal Updates

Richard Wade Litigation

We are pleased to report that our former CEO Richard Wade has been successfully sued and found liable for violating his fiduciary responsibilities and embezzlement for personal gain. The verdict awarded us over \$21 million. However, Mr. Wade has appealed the ruling to the Texas Supreme Court. Our attorney, Pete Harry, has filed a robust response, and we are optimistic that the Texas Supreme Court will uphold the verdict. Despite the favorable judgment, we do not anticipate receiving any of this award due to Mr. Wade's financial situation.

Vertical Computer Systems Inc. and NOW Solutions, Inc. vs. Derek Wolman and Davidoff, Hutcher, and Citron LLP

The current Board, on behalf of VCSY shareholders, has filed a lawsuit in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas Sherman Division (CASE NO. 4:24cv395). The case details are available on our <u>investor page</u>.

This lawsuit arises from actions taken by Derek Wolman, a partner at Davidoff, Hutcher, and Citron LLP, which involved sweeping NOW Solutions' TD Bank account. This issue was only brought to our attention by this action and opened us to further discover the wrongs committed. These discoveries are numerous claims were filed in Federal Court. Pete Harry, Attorney at Law, is leading this RICO case. The defendants have been served and acknowledged receipt of the suit in the first week of June 2024. The Board is committed to pursuing justice for our shareholders and will keep you informed as the case progresses.

James Salz v. Vertical Computer Systems, Inc., NOW Solutions, Inc., Priority Time Systems, Inc., and Leonard Chermack

Case Details:

- **Court:** Los Angeles Superior Court
- Case No.: 24STCV05304

James Salz filed a lawsuit against the Company on March 1, 2024, seeking collection of past wages, interest, and penalties allegedly dating back over a decade. VCSY has retained Pettit Kohn, a firm specializing in employment law, to handle our defense. We filed our response to Mr. Salz's allegations on May 31, 2024.

Cross-Complaint: In addition to responding to Mr. Salz's allegations, Pettit Kohn referred us to Garcia Hong Law Firm. Attorney Valerie Hong, who specializes in malpractice and is a former Pettit Kohn attorney, has filed a cross-complaint against James Salz and some of these charges are brought against Chad Biggins of Biggins Law Firm. The cross-complaint includes the following claims:

- 1. Breach of Fiduciary Duty
- 2. Legal Malpractice
- 3. Fraud
- 4. Breach of Implied Covenant of Good Faith and Fair Dealing
- 5. Violation of Books & Records Demand

This cross-complaint is tied to Mr. Salz's and Mr. Biggins involvement in the Lakeshore litigation prior to our engagement with Pettit Kohn.

Commitment to Transparency

The Board remains dedicated to keeping shareholders informed about significant legal proceedings. We understand the importance of transparency and will continue to provide updates where possible. Thank you for your ongoing support and trust.
